

Gymnastics Blocks Terms and Conditions



1. Governance

Acrobay is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO) registered charity number SC045182

We are GymMark accredited. The GymMark Scheme has been developed by British Gymnastics. Its purpose is to provide recognition for clubs that are committed to providing quality experiences, encouraging young people to take up sport, whilst focusing on improving their talent and maintaining a life long participation in sport. Gaining GymMark accreditation means that our club is recognised by British Gymnastics and their partners as a safe, effective and child friendly club, providing a service in the community that children and young people, their parents/carers and others with a passion for Gymnastics can trust.

2. Sessions and Payment

Places on gymnastic sessions are subject to availability and can only be booked at the club reception, emailing us on info@acrobay.co.uk or enquiring through our website. Places will only be confirmed once payment has been received, along with a completed membership form and signed T&C. Contact us on 01383 249951.

Payments can be made using debit or credit cards either at the club reception or over the phone (01383 249951), Cash or card payment can be made at the reception.

If you have difficulties in making payments for your child's sessions please discuss this with a member of the office team.

Late payment of fees will incur a £5 late payment charge.

We make every effort to ensure that the details on the website or in flyers are correct but we reserve the right to make amendments if necessary at any time.

When making a booking, it is your responsibility to ensure that any gymnast is the correct age for that session. We reserve the right to refuse entry to a session if any participant is found not to be of the correct age, unless a specific arrangement has been made with the lead coach.

You must inform us of any medical condition, or disability, which may be relevant to the child booked on to a gymnastic session. You must also notify us of any change or deterioration of any such medical condition or disability. We will keep this information confidential and handle such issues with discretion. It is our policy to include any such individuals within the scheduled

courses wherever possible, but we reserve the right to refuse the booking if we are regrettably unable to accommodate the needs of the individual at Acrobay Gymnastics Trust.

3. Insurance

If you are successful at obtaining a place on a session payment and registration must be made online to British Gymnastics. Gymnasts can only participate in a session if British Gymnastics membership/insurance has been paid in full. If you have not paid your membership then your child will not be able to participate in the session. If after the first session your child decides he/she does not want to continue this will be refunded to you.

The British Gymnastics membership year runs from 1 October to 30 September each year. Membership will renew on 1 October each year whereupon members will become liable to pay a Membership fee for the new Membership year. This must be renewed direct with British Gymnastics.

4. Clothing and Footwear

All user groups should ensure that correct clothing and footwear are worn for specific activities. Cultural differences and the specific needs of disabled people will be respected. No outdoor shoes should be worn within the Gymnastics Training Centre or any of the Studios.

5. Equal Opportunities

Acrobay Gymnastics Trust has a policy of equal opportunity for all regardless of gender, ability, ethnic or cultural background. Bookings are accepted on the understanding that user groups conform with Acrobay's Policy.

6. Conduct

Facility users will be held responsible for damage to equipment/fittings/furnishings and premises unless deemed to be reasonable/acceptable wear and tear. Facilities should be left in good order and a safe condition. Bookings are accepted on the understanding that regulations concerning the safety and convenience of the participants are observed.

7. Evacuation

Users should familiarise themselves with the evacuation procedures of the venue. In the event of any emergency situation arising advice and directions from Acrobay staff should be strictly adhered to.

8. Electrical Equipment

Portable electrical equipment may only be used in the facility if it has been PAT tested.

9. Security

Changing facilities are provided. It is advised that these facilities are used and that bags and belongings are not taken into activity areas. User groups should note that Acrobay does not accept responsibility for the loss of personal belongings, etc.

10. Photography

The use of camera, video and other equipment with the capacity to photograph is not permitted without prior arrangement with Acrobay staff.
